YASAR KEMAL

Yaşar Kemal, the great plane tree of our literature, is the first nominated writer and story writer from our country, who was nominated for the Nobel Prize for Literature, whose works were translated into many languages, who benefited from the legends and tales of Anatolia.



The first works of Yasar Kemal, who witnessed the murder of his father at the age of five in the mosque and had a difficult childhood, were serialized in the newspaper Republic, in which ince Memed was translated into nearly forty languages.



Although he was named as Kemal Sadık Gökceli in various publications until the 50s, he used the name Yaşar Kemal in his works after he was published in Republic newspaper He died on February 28, 2015, at the age of 91, in the hospital where he was in intensive care due to organ failure. His body was identified at the Zincirlikuyu Cemetery with a ceremony held on March 2, 2015.





Summary Of The Fine Memed Novel

The fine Memed quartet, written over a period of 32 years, is the narrative of Memed, who rebelled against the order, and Çukurova with its human relations, transportation and colors. The events in Ince Memed take place in the first years of the Republican era. It is a story of rebellion against this situation due the backwardness, ignorance of the Anatolian natives, the misery of the village journeys and the total domination of the aghas in the whole region.

Değirmenoluk is one of the five villages in Dikenliözü, which stretches from the Taurus Mountains to the Mediterranean. The laws and customs set by Abdi Ağa are applied in this village. Memed, one of the young men of the village, has been plowing Abdi Ağa's field for days. When he realizes that he can't stand it anymore, he leaves everything and goes to Kemse Village and takes refuge in Süleyman. Memed spends the winter in Cutting Village. Although he misses his mother and his village, he is determined not to return. One day, this situation is reported to Abdi Ağa. Abdi Ağa takes Memed to the village. That summer, Memed again

plowed Abdi Ağa's land.

Memed goes to town for the first time with his friend Mustafa. Town life affects Memed a lot. Memed kidnaps his lover Hatce from his village. Hatce is also the fiancee of Abdi Ağa's nephew. Agha's men and his nephew take clues to catch them. remove the conflict between them. Abdi Ağa's nephew dies. Hatçe is captured, while Memed is injured and runs away. Memed takes refuge in the gang of a bandit called Deli Durdu. Meanwhile, Abdi Ağa sets a trap for Hatçe to punish him. He convinces the gendarmes that Hatce killed his nephew and Hatce falls into prison.

When Memed comes to his village one night, he learns that his mother died and what happened to Hatçe. Then he starts to follow Abdi Ağa's permission. Meanwhile, Abdi Ağa sets up a trap to eliminate him. Memed finds Hatce in town and finds a way, and manages to break her and her friend out of prison. Abdi Ağa sends a telegram to Ankara and reports the hiding place of Memed. The gendarmes ensnare Memed. remove the conflict between them. Just at this time, Hatce gives birth. Memed surrenders for his wife and child; but meanwhile, Hatce is shot. Asım Sergeant, who has been chasing him for months, cannot arrest him in this state and gives him a new chance. Hatce's prison friend, Iraz, takes the child born, and he moves to a village in Gaziantep. Blaming Abdi Ağa responsible for the events, Memed comes to the village and rides his horse towards the mountains after shooting Abdi Ağa. After that day, Memed is never heard from again.
